Our Association Purpose; To engender greater fellowship and knowledge among the Midwest Shrine Centers and their members; and to secure greater recognition of the institution of Shiner's International throughout the territory of this association

The Chief Rabban of each Shrine Center is responsible to ensure all delegates have registered and housing rooms have been requested with the MSA Secretary/Treasurer through his shrine center using the registration and housing forms provided. Fees for registration and rooms are in **US FUNDS**.

REGISTRATION: Registration for the 2022 MSA Winter session is \$116.20/person (US Funds) which includes Breakfast, Lunch, and the Banquet on Friday as well as Breakfast on Saturday and access for delegates into the sessions. Nobles who are not registered will not be provided with meals. All meals will be in the Green Bay Radisson and Convention Center.

HOUSING; The Green Bay Radisson Hotel and Conference Center is the host hotel and the MSA has blocked a total of 120 guestrooms (30 King Singles & 90 Queen Doubles) at a cost of \$114.35/night (US Funds).

HOSPITALITY ROOMS; MSA has reserved the Plaza Club for 3 Temples and the State Board Room for 2 Temples to share. If more rooms are required or a Temple does not wish to share a hospitality room a guestroom on the main floor in the same area as the 2 hospitality rooms can be reserved, however the Temple will require to pay the room rate of \$114.35/night. Additionally, the furniture in these rooms cannot be removed.

All rooms will be reserved and assigned to Shrine Centers in order of registration received. Checkout is 11:00 AM (**extended checkout with fee may be available, check at front desk**) luggage storage is available.

The deadline for registration and housing requests is January 14, 2022.

Vehicle and Bus Parking is Available in the Hotel Parking Lot.

PAST M.S.A. OFFICERS: All Past M.S.A. officers **must register and make room reservations through their own Shrine Centers.**

IMPERIAL OFFICERS: At this time we have not been advised which Imperial officers will be attending

LADIES: The MSA Winter business session is a stag event. There are **no** activities planned or arranged for the ladies or families during MSA Winter Business Sessions.

ROOMS: Room rates (US Funds) are indicated above and also on the Housing registration form. The M.S.A. Sec/Treas. will attempt to honor all special room type requests based on receipt date of housing form provided by the Shrine Center.

Room Requests and Delegate Registrations are due to the Secretary Treasurer by 5:00 PM, Friday January 14, 2022. The Shrine Centers will be invoiced based upon registrations as of that date. Rooms requested after this date may not be available in this hotel or at the MSA Rate.

Meals – Meals are provided for registered delegates only. Each registered delegate will be provided with a name tag must be visible for access for meals. General delegates breakfast buffet will be held in the Turtle Bear Room beginning at 7:00 AM and close at 8:15 both Friday and Saturday mornings. The Potentates, Chief Rabbans, Assistant Rabbans, High Priests & Prophets, Oriental Guides and Treasurers/Recorders will have their individual counterpart's breakfast on Friday Feb 11, 2022 at 7:00 AM. (Rooms to be determined). This time can be used by those groups to discuss activities for the year or any matters they wish to present at the General Business session. Lunch and the Banquet on Friday will be in the Turtle bear room as well.

The M.S.A. Executive Committee; will meet for breakfast at 7:00 AM on Saturday morning February 8, 2020. *Executive Committee Members are; M.S.A. elected officers, Past M.S.A. Officers, Imperial Officers and member Temple Potentates.* (Chief Rabbans are invited to attend as guests).
